Q060409-1. Please confirm that new facilities that have not already initiated the LGIP process do NOT need to submit a Large Generator Interconnection Request Form as shown in Attachment F to the RFP.

A. Bidders must include all completed forms and attachments with their proposals for their submittals to be deemed complete.

Bidders who are planning to interconnect a facility directly to the BH/Colorado Electric transmission system are not required to include interconnection cost estimates in their pricing if they have not yet initiated the LGIP process. The information provided in Attachment F will be used by the BH/Colorado Electric transmission function to develop a generic interconnection cost estimate for the bidder so that they may then adjust their pricing.

Bidders who are not planning to propose a facility directly interconnected to the BH/Colorado Electric transmission system must also provide a completed Attachment F so that the bid evaluation team can evaluate the existing or proposed interconnection to a third party transmission system as part of a risk assessment.
